Oral Surgery Post Operative Sinus Precautions:

Your surgical procedure was at or near the maxillary sinus above your upper teeth. Please follow these precautions to prevent a permanent opening between your sinus and your mouth that usually requires further surgical procedures to address.

- 1. Please do not blow your nose for at least 2 weeks or longer as determined at your follow-up appointments. If you have to sneeze, do so with your mouth open.
- 2. Do not use a straw and avoid activities that create suction in the mouth or increase pressure in the sinuses.
- 3. Please take all medications prescribed by your surgeon: often including nasal sprays, decongestants (pseudoephedrine) and antibiotics (Amoxicillin, etc) to keep your sinus from becoming infected.
- 4. Do not spit/rinse vigorously for the first 2 weeks after surgery.
- 5. No flying in non-pressurized aircraft during the first two weeks.
- 6. Do not pull out/remove any packing that may be placed in the surgical site.
- 7. Please come to all follow-up appointments that have been scheduled for you.
