PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS HAVING INTRAVENOUS SEDATION

- 1. Plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment.
- Please have a responsible adult accompany you during your visit, WHO MUST REMAIN
 IN THE OFFICE DURING YOUR SURGERY, drive you home and plan to spend the remainder of the day with you.
- 3. Have **NOTHING TO EAT OR DRINK (INCLUDING WATER, GUM, and MINTS ECT.) FOR (8) HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE.** Otherwise the surgery will be rescheduled.
- 4. Please wear short sleeves and remove jewelry and contact lenses prior to your appointment. Please limit the amount of facial makeup.
- 5. Please brush your teeth and rinse your mouth thoroughly prior to your appointment.
- 6. Please take any medicine recommended by your doctors or staff with a **SIP OF WATER**.
- 7. If you are pregnant you **CANNOT** have IV sedation.
- 8. If you are nursing, Please pump enough breast milk to feed your child for 1 week.
- 9. No recreational drug use prior to your procedure.
- 10. No alcohol for 24 hours prior to your procedure.
- 11. There will be a charge for any appointment not rescheduled or cancelled with a 48 hour notice.
- 12. Please bring a list of all the medications you are currently taking.
- 13. If you were given a medical clearance form for your doctor, please bring it with you.
